the City of Davenport supports programs that further sustainability as evidenced by its commitment to the U.S. Conference of Mayor's Climate Protection Agreement; its Clean Water, Water Pollution Control, Compost and Recycling program, and its multi-modal transportation plans; and by continuously practicing and innovating to reduce resources consumed in the delivery of City services; and
