New Restrictions on lowa Voters

Early Voting can be done

- By mail or hand delivery to the Auditor's office (absentee voting);
- In person at the Auditor's office; or
- In person at a satellite location, if one is available.

Absentee and Early Voting

- The first day to vote early in person at the Auditor's office is
 20 days before the election. (was 29 days)
- Satellite voting locations (like branch libraries and community centers) require 100 voters to petition for a location. (was the Auditor's decision)
- Absentee ballots must be received by the Auditor by 8 pm on election day. (Formerly, ballots were counted if postmarked before election day and received by the following Monday.)
- Absentee ballots may be hand delivered to the Auditor only by the voter, an immediate family member or someone living in the voter's household. (In the past voters could have their ballot delivered by anyone of their choosing.)

Voting at the Polls

- Polls close at 8 pm. (formerly, 9 pm for primary and general elections)
- Employers must allow employees a minimum of two consecutive hours to vote on election day. (was three hours)
